Promoter

The Fundraiser is conducted by Stramit Corporation Pty Limited located at Level 4, 68 Waterloo Road Macquarie Park NSW 2113 Australia.

Nominated Charity

Australian Red Cross Society, to support Red Cross Bushfire Appeal

Participating Customers

To participate in the Fundraiser, a Participating Customer must:

- (a) be a resident of Australia aged 18 years and over;
- (b) have an existing Trading Account with the Promoter;
- (c) place an Order directly with the Promoter; and

Order

Donation
